The Hatred of Music Pascal Quignard 2016-03-28 Throughout Pascal Quignard's distinguished literary career, music has been a recurring obsession. So Vast the Prison Assia Djebar 2011-01-04 *So Vast the Prison* is the double-threaded story of a modern, educated Algerian woman existing in a man's society, and, not surprisingly, living a life of contradictions.
