Descriptive Essays, or Essays that consist of the description of some place or thing. These may be animals,

plants, fruits, or minerals ; towns, ports, ships, and buildings of all kinds, as towers, temples, museums, bridges; countries, islands, mountains, seas; rivers, canals ; aspects of nature; or, lastly, manufactured articles. III. Reflective Essays, or Essays that consist of reflection upon some topic, which is generally of an abstract nature. These topics may be habits, qualities, feelings, and capacities; or they may be subjects of a social and political character. IV. Expository Essays, or Essays that consist of the exposition or explanation of subjects. These may be comprised under the head of - first, institutions, industries, occupations, and phrase of life; secondly, scientific topics; and thirdly, literary topics.
